Ponies 153cm or under (Shetlands exempt) do not need a JMB height certificate in order to enter these classes but MUST have a 2023 valid JMB height certificate to enter the RIHS Finals

Competitors qualifying at this show for The Royal International Horse Show 25th-31st July 2023 must submit their entries ONLINE at <https://www.hickstead.co.uk/entries-results-schooling/longines-royal-international-horse-show/> Schedules and entry forms will be available to download in April 2023. Online entries will be open on 2nd May and entries close on 5th June 2023 All stallions must be graded and licensed by BSPA for 2023 and must wear BSPA Stallion ID Disc. No rider under 14 may exhibit a stallion in any class.

No competitor/owner/horse may compete in this class or enter the ring without current 2023 membership of BSPA, and a RIHS qualification card. Memberships/ horse registrations must be in place before you enter classes.

Qualification: 1st place and the next unqualified competitor standing 2nd or 3rd qualify from each class. No competitor may qualify from lower than 3rd place. RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

RULES

It is a Condition of Entry that Exhibitors agree to be bound by the rules hereunder.

Equine Influenza vaccinations are a compulsory requirement for all horses/ponies competing in all affiliated classes.

- 1 The Show will be run in accordance with the 2023 NPS Rulebook.
- 2 All stallions and colts two years old and over must hold a current Stallion Licence, unless otherwise governed by their individual Breed Society.
- 3 All M&M ponies must be registered in their respective stud books and shown as per Breed Society rules.
- 4 The Judge's decision will be final.
- 5 Substitute and nomination entries are not allowed.
- 6 The Show or any of its officers, servants or assistants shall not be held responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage that may happen from/to any animal, property or vehicle brought onto the showground, or whilst entering or leaving the same, or otherwise in connection with or arising out of or attributable to the Show or to the conditions or rules prescribed by the Committee thereto.
- 7 Each Exhibitor shall be solely responsible for any consequential loss, injury or damage done to or occasioned by or arising from any animal, including the spread of infection or contagious disease or article exhibited or introduced to the showground by him or her and shall indemnify the Show and its officials against all actions, proceedings, liabilities, claims, damages and expenses in relation to or arising from his/her entries in the Show.
- 8 Making entry/entries in the Show shall be deemed to be an acceptance of these conditions.
- 9 Objections to entries or awards must be made in writing to the Secretary, on the Show Day accompanied by a deposit of £50, which will be refunded if the objection is sustained. All objections shall be delivered to the Secretariat within an hour of the occurrence,/incident otherwise they will not be considered.
- 10 Absolutely no parking on the drive to Onley Grounds.
- 11 In the interest of safety, lunging is only permitted in allocated signed areas.
- 12 Handlers of stallions or colts must have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January of the current year.
- 13 Members of individual Breed Societies must make themselves aware and abide by the NPS Rules when competing in affiliated classes.
- 14 Handlers of ponies in in-hand classes aged 14 years and under must wear correctly secured current British standard skull caps/riding hats.
- 15 It is the owner's due diligence to ensure that horses/ponies are not left unattended whilst tied to the side of trailers/lorries.
- 16 Exhibitors are **not** allowed to set up corrals in the lorry park.
- 17 In the interest of safety, please obey the instructions of the Show Committee or any other Official of the Show at all times.

- 21 All horses and ponies must comply with current BEF vaccination regulations.

British Show Pony Society classes. This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society ('B.S.P.S.'), and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in B.S.P.S. classes, whether or not members of the B.S.P.S. are subject to constitution and Rules of this society including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of this society. In all classes affiliated to the B.S.P.S., the B.S.P.S. Rules take precedence.

UK PONIES & HORSES Summer Classic 2023, Owners must be Adult / Life Members, Riders must be current UK Ponies & Horses Limited Annual Members and the ponies currently registered with UK Ponies & Horses Limited before time of entry in order to compete in these classes. Open to Mountain and Moorland Ridden Stallion (Intermediate class only), Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Connemara, Dartmoor, Dales, Exmoor, Fells, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C or D.

The highest placed exhibit not already qualified within the first five will qualify for the UK Ponies & Horses Limited RIHS Young Riders M&M Ridden. The highest placed pony and rider not already qualified within the first five will qualify for the UK Ponies & Horses Limited RIHS Amateur Riders M&M Finals at the RIHS Hickstead in July 2023 Qualification will be verified by the office.

UK PONIES & HORSES LIMITED AMATEUR RULES It is expected that Exhibitors will compete in the true spirit of these Rules.

The Directors/Board reserve the right, in their absolute discretion, to reclassify an Exhibitor's Amateur status/entry should they deem it necessary. Ownership: All owners should be registered in the passport as per the latest DEFRA regulations. Professional

Producer/Trainer/Rider: A person who undertakes the preparation/training/keeping at livery, production of equines/riders or competes as a Rider or jobbing Rider. Professional Groom: A person who is employed full, part-time or is self-employed and receives remuneration,

monetary or otherwise, for the preparation/training/keeping or production of equines. No commercial branding can be visible in the ring, during a class, this applies to equines, riders and any attendees. (A) Professional Showing Status: anyone who has operated as a

Professional Showing Producer, Rider or Groom will, for the purposes of these Rules, always be deemed a professional; including when acting as a Groom. (B) Amateur Status – a person is an Amateur for the purpose of classes run under Association Rules if he/she does not: (i)

Judge at an affiliated show, as of 1st January in the current year (this Rule comes in to effect as of 1st January 2023). (C) Amateur Status – a person is an Amateur for the purpose of classes run under Association Rules if he/she does not, during the current or previous season: (i) Engage in breeding, livery, buying, selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity, or as means of deriving a source of income.

() Receive remuneration, whether it be monetary or goods in kind, for employment in the connection with horses in racing, showing, livery stable or riding school (instruction at Pony Club and Riding Club excepted). This does not include the suppliers of ancillary services such as farriers and vets. Own/Part own an equestrian establishment including but not limited to riding schools, events centre, stud or livery yard in

any capacity, or receive any form of remuneration for employment at an equestrian establishment. For the avoidance of doubt for the purpose of this rule, immediate family members of an owner or part owner of an equestrian establishment who work or are howsoever otherwise engaged or involved in any capacity, whether or not for remuneration at the equestrian establishment, will be treated as being an owner or part

owner of that equestrian establishment. Show a Horse owned or sponsored by a company or a commercial firm, or act as a Brand Ambassador, in any showing classes, UK Ponies & Horses or otherwise, or a Horse for which his/her immediate family accepts livery or

training charges from a person outside the immediate family concerned. A competitor is not eligible to compete in Amateur classes on an Exhibit, which has been ridden by a Professional Rider in any Open classes, UK Ponies & Horses or otherwise, with the exception of

Open Working classes and Side Saddle classes, during the current year and the following year, up to but not including the Royal International Horse Show. (The above Rule does not apply, if the Horse has been Professionally Produced and ONLY ridden by a

Professional, during the current season, or if the horse has subsequently been sold and re-registered under new Ownership). () If you ride/compete equines on a regular basis, which you do not stable at home, your Amateur status will be reviewed by the Board, i.e., if you

ride/compete multiple equines or ride regularly for one or more owners, you could be deemed professional. On the day when an Exhibit is competing in Amateur classes, Professionals, including Professional Grooms, are not allowed to ride, to work-in (in any form),

compete, or enter the Ring to groom/strip the Horse. (D) Amateur Owner/Rider: Open to Horses owned and ridden by an Amateur. This ruling will also apply to Amateurs who wish to compete in the Annual Amateur Points Awards. No Professional, including Professional

Grooms, are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse. (E) Amateur Home Produced: Open to Horses, which are either stabled at home or in a D. I. Y. yard and which since 1st January in the current year, have not been shown by a Professional during the current

season or stabled in a Professional yard at any time in the current year. To be ridden by an Amateur. This does not exclude Amateur Owner Home Produced riders having lessons at any time with an instructor, providing the Horse remains stabled at home. No

Professional, including Professional Grooms, are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse.

NPS Summer Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in any of the British Riding Pony studbook sections or the Ridden Register; the GSB; the AHSB; the AASB, or registered in the main body of

their respective M&M Stud Book. Part breeds are not eligible unless over stamped into one of the British Riding Pony studbook sections, or the Ridden Register. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and nonmembers but

only ponies owned by adult NPS **Qualifying or Life** members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 1st-3rd August 2023

The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer

Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards **MUST** be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

NPS/SUPREME PRODUCTS M&M WHP RIHS: Owner's must be Qualifying or life members to enter the qualifying class.

NPS Winter Championship Qualifying Rounds

This show is affiliated to the National Pony Society and the NPS affiliated classes will be run under NPS rules. Classes are open to Members and Non-Members of the NPS, but Non-Members will need to become members to enter the finals at the NPS Spring Festival 2023. The NPS General Rules for Showing apply (see NPS website for details).

In each class the three highest placed ponies, not already qualified, within the first six places, will qualify. Winnings in the 2022/2023 Novice and Pure Novice Winter Championships will not debar ponies from the NPS 2023 Mountain and Moorland Novice Ridden competitions. Qualification cards will be awarded in the ring.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a **Qualifying or Life** member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette, but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show 1-3 August 2023
