RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Neither the NPS Area 13 Committee, Judges, Stewards or Assistants shall in any way be held responsible or accountable for any theft, accident, injury, loss or damage (howsoever this may be caused) to any exhibit, person, animal, property, vehicles brought on to the showground, any premises used in conjunction with, arising out of or attainable to the show. It shall be a condition of entry that each entrant or spectator shall indemnify the show organisers and proprietors against any legal proceedings arising from any accident or misdemeanor. NPS Area 13 is covered by Public Liability insurance. Competitors should ensure that they hold adequate third party insurance cover in respect of any accident caused by themselves, their family, or helpers, their vehicles or animals when on the showground.
2. Judges decision is final provided all relevant rules have been followed. The class ends when the judge dismisses the class.
3. Stallions and colts, 2 years old and over must be suitably bitted and must be in possession of a current NPS or appropriate breed society license unless otherwise governed by their individual Breed Society.
4. In all cases, whips/canes must not exceed 30" in length.
5. Objections to be made in writing to the show secretary, together with a deposit of £40, within one hour of the disputed event. If the objection is upheld the deposit will be forfeited.
6. Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current Safety Standards/specifications MUST be worn by all Riders of all ages. All PAS 015; VG1; (BS)EN1384 2017; ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2001; SNELL E2016; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards.
7. The most recent updates to the list are the addition of SNELL E2016 and EN1384 (2017); the newest version of the SNELL Standard could have begun to appear in 2017 and is accepted to the list; the newest version of the EN1384 Standard will begin to appear during 2018 and is also accepted to the list. Handlers of ponies in the In Hand classes aged 14 years and under must wear correctly secured British Standard skull/riding hats.
8. If for any reason the show has to be cancelled; only half the entry fee will be refunded. In no other case will any entry fee be refunded.
9. In all M & M classes, ridden and in hand, ponies must be shown as recommended by their breed society rules, and are restricted to the heights laid down by their appropriate breed societies.
10. All exhibitors must be in control of their animals at all times and any animal considered to constitute a danger will be asked to leave the showground immediately.
11. No telephone entries.
12. The show organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without giving a reason.
13. The committee reserves the right to substitute judges without warning or amalgamate classes due to insufficient entries in one class. All dogs must be kept on leads.

Ponies must be registered in any of the British Riding Pony studbook sections or the Ridden Register; the GSB; the AHSB; the AASB, or registered in the main body of their respective M&M Stud Book. Part bred are not eligible unless over stamped into one of the British Riding Pony studbook sections. or the Ridden Register.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and nonmembers but only ponies owned by adult NPS **Qualifying or Life** members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from **2nd – 4th August 2022**.

The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards **MUST** be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

NPS/SUPREME PRODUCTS M&M WHP RIHS: Owner's must be Qualifying or life members to enter the qualifying class.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a **Qualifying or Life** member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette, but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show **2nd -4th August 2022**

British Show Pony Society classes.

This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society ('B.S.P.S.'), and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in B.S.P.S. classes, whether or not members of the B.S.P.S. are subject to constitution and Rules of this society including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of this society. In all classes affiliated to the BSPS, the BSPS Rules take precedence.

Shows from 1st March 2022 – 30th April 2022 will award qualification for: UK PONIES & HORSES Summer Classic 2022, Equifest 2022 & BSPA 2022: Owners must be Adult / Life Members, Riders must be current UK Ponies & Horses Limited Annual Members and the ponies currently registered with UK Ponies & Horses Limited before time of entry in order to compete in these classes. Open to Mountain and Moorland Ridden Stallion (Intermediate class only), Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Connemara, Dartmoor, Dales, Exmoor, Fells, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C or D. The highest placed exhibit not already qualified within the first five will qualify for the UK Ponies & Horses Limited RIHS Young Riders M&M Ridden. The highest placed pony and rider not already qualified within the first five will qualify for the UK Ponies & Horses Limited RIHS Amateur Riders M&M Finals at the RIHS Hickstead in July 2022 Qualification will be verified by the office.

UK PONIES & HORSES LIMITED AMATEUR RULES

It is expected that Exhibitors will compete in the true spirit of these Rules. The Directors/Board reserve the right, in their absolute discretion, to reclassify an Exhibitor's Amateur status/entry should they deem it necessary.

Ownership: All owners should be registered in the passport as per the latest DEFRA regulations.

Professional Producer/Trainer/Rider: A person who undertakes the preparation/training/keeping at livery, production of equines/riders or competes as a Rider or jobbing Rider.

Professional Groom: A person who is employed full, part-time or is self-employed and receives remuneration, monetary or otherwise, for the preparation/training/keeping or production of equines.

No commercial branding can be visible in the ring, during a class, this applies to equines, riders and any attendees.

(A) Professional Showing Status: anyone who has operated as a Professional Showing Producer, Rider or Groom will, for the purposes of these Rules, always be deemed a professional; including when acting as a Groom.

(B) Amateur Status – a person is an Amateur for the purpose of classes run under Association Rules if he/she does not:

(i) Judge at an affiliated show, as of 1st January in the current year (this Rule comes in to effect as of 1st January 2023).

(C) Amateur Status – a person is an Amateur for the purpose of classes run under Association Rules if he/she does not, during the current or previous season:

(i) Engage in breeding, livery, buying, selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity, or as means of deriving a source of income.

() Receive remuneration, whether it be monetary or goods in kind, for employment in the connection with horses in racing, showing, livery stable or riding school (instruction at Pony Club and Riding Club excepted). This does not include the suppliers of ancillary services such as farriers and vets.

(i) Own/Part own an equestrian establishment including but not limited to riding schools, events centre, stud or livery yard in any capacity, or receive any form of remuneration for employment at an equestrian establishment. For the avoidance of doubt for the purpose of this rule, immediate family members of an owner or part owner of an equestrian establishment who work or are howsoever otherwise engaged or involved in any capacity, whether or not for remuneration at the equestrian establishment, will be treated as being an owner or part owner of that equestrian establishment.

(ii) Show a Horse owned or sponsored by a company or a commercial firm, or act as a Brand Ambassador, in any showing classes, UK Ponies & Horses or otherwise, or a Horse for which his/her immediate family accepts livery or training charges from a person outside the immediate family concerned. A competitor is not eligible to compete in Amateur classes on an Exhibit, which has been ridden by a Professional Rider in any Open classes, UK Ponies & Horses or otherwise, with the exception of Open Working classes and Side Saddle classes, during the current year and the following year, up to but not including the Royal International Horse Show.

(The above Rule does not apply, if the Horse has been Professionally Produced and ONLY ridden by a Professional, during the current season, or if the horse has subsequently been sold and re-registered under new Ownership).

() If you ride/compete equines on a regular basis, which you do not stable at home, your Amateur status will be reviewed by the Board, i.e., if you ride/compete multiple equines or ride regularly for one or more owners, you could be deemed professional.

On the day when an Exhibit is competing in Amateur classes, Professionals, including Professional Grooms, are not allowed to ride, to work-in (in any form), compete, or enter the Ring to groom/strip the Horse.

(D) Amateur Owner/Rider: Open to Horses owned and ridden by an Amateur. This ruling will also apply to Amateurs who wish to compete in the Annual Amateur Points Awards. No Professional, including Professional Grooms, are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse.

(E) Amateur Home Produced: Open to Horses, which are either stabled at home or in a D. I. Y. yard and which since 1st January in the current year, have not been shown by a Professional during the current season or stabled in a Professional yard at any time in the current year. To be ridden by an Amateur. This does not exclude Amateur Owner Home Produced riders having lessons at any time with an instructor, providing the Horse remains stabled at home. No Professional, including Professional Grooms, are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse.
